

Premier visit at AdOM

Kathleen Wynne, Premier of Ontario, Canada, and her staff visited AdOM on May 16th, to strengthen commercial collaborations between Israel and Ontario. The Premier was accompanied by Dr. Eric Hoskins, Minister of Health and Long Term Care and the Hon. Reza Moridi, Minister of Research and Innovation.



Prof. Harris presented AdOM to the distinguished delegation highlighting the breakthrough device that was developed by AdOM's talented team at minimal cost. The Tear Film Imager (TFI) device is the first device for clinical usage to measure the aqueous and the lipid sub-layers of the tear film directly at nanometer resolution over time. Moreover, the TFI's two minutes noncontact test provides the physician for the first time a clear diagnostic of the dry eye syndrome and its root cause.

The Premier and the Hon. Reza were the first Ontarians to take the TFI test for dry eye diagnostics. Both reported that the test felt comfortable, as with other eye imaging devices.

Dr. Piyush Patel, Inflamax CEO, joined the visit and an MOU was signed to expand on the AdOM-Inflamax collaboration. Inflamax is a CRO organization based in Ontario Canada, specializing in performing clinical studies for dry eye syndrome and its therapies. Inflamax will conduct the first overseas clinical study of the AdOM Tear Film Imager (TFI) in Canada later this year. AdOM's collaboration with Inflamax comes at a significant stage of AdOM's conducting clinical studies towards approval of its device, and expanding the collaboration with Inflamax will serve the interests of both parties.
